The truth is that Washington is broken – rigged by the powerful special interests and lobbyists to benefit the very few at the expense of the rest of us. Because our government no longer works for most families, we risk becoming the first generation of Americans that fails to pass on a better life to our children.

- *End the War in Iraq:* We should immediately withdraw 40,000 to 50,000 combat troops and bring home the rest within nine to ten months. We also need a "diplomatic surge" to engage all nations in the region in reaching a political solution in Iraq.
- Guarantee Universal Health Care: This is a moral issue. I will stand up to the big drug and insurance companies and guarantee health care for every American, while cutting costs and improving care. My plan costs \$90 billion to \$120 billion. To pay for it, I will repeal the Bush tax cuts for families above \$200,000 a year to pay for it.
- Support Middle-Class Families: I will raise the minimum wage, strengthen workers' rights to organize and reject bad

trade deals. I will help families save, cut taxes for middle-class families, protect pensions and lift millions out of poverty.

- Teach Our Children: We must end No Child Left Behind's punitive approach and restore a comprehensive curriculum. I support universal early childhood education, smaller classes and better teacher pay. My College for Everyone plan will make college affordable for every student willing to work part-time.
- Achieve Energy Independence and Fight Global Warming: The crisis of global warming demands action today. I will cap and reduce greenhouse gases by 80 percent by 2050, as scientists say is necessary, and invest in innovation and renewable energy to create new jobs that cannot be sent overseas.
- Revitalize Rural America: My Rural Recovery Act will invest in local Main Street businesses, attract new industries like renewable energy and strengthen rural schools. I will stand up for family farms with country-of-origin labeling, antitrust enforcement, a ban on packer ownership and a moratorium on building or expanding concentrated animal feeding operations.



JOHN EDWARDS' PLAN FOR TRUE UNIVERSAL HEALTH CARE

Summary

Forty-seven million Americans without health care is a moral outrage. John Edwards was the first major presidential candidate to propose a detailed plan that takes on the big drug and insurance companies to guarantee quality, affordable care for every American.

The Edwards Health Care Plan

- Universal coverage through shared responsibility
- Affordable and higher quality health care
- New strategies for prescription drugs, long-term care, cancer, HIV/AIDS and nursing shortages

UNIVERSAL COVERAGE THROUGH SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

Outline of the Edwards Plan

- Require by law that every American have comprehensive health coverage, including mental health coverage.
- Require businesses to either cover their employees or help pay their premiums.
- Make insurance affordable by creating new tax credits, expanding Medicaid and SCHIP, reforming insurance laws and taking innovative steps to contain health care costs.
- Create new Health Care Markets to give families and businesses purchasing power and a choice of quality plans, including one public plan.

Impact of the Edwards Plan

- Families without insurance will get coverage at an affordable price.
- Families with insurance will pay less and get more security and choices.
- Employers will find it cheaper and easier to insure their workers.

 The health care system could evolve into a singlepayer approach if Americans choose to enroll in the public plan instead of private insurance.

Honesty about the Cost

We need to be honest about paying for universal health care. The Edwards plan costs \$90-\$120 billion a year. He will pay for it by repealing President Bush's tax cuts for Americans who make over \$200,000 a year and reforming health care to get better care at lower cost.

AFFORDABLE AND HIGHER QUALITY HEALTH CARE

Edwards' cost-saving measures will save an average insured family \$2,000 to \$2,500 a year and eliminate at least \$130 billion a year in wasteful spending.

Get Tough on Big Insurance and Drug Companies

- Outlaw discrimination against people with preexisting conditions and require insurers to spend at least 85 percent of their premiums on patient care.
- Make private insurers compete with a public plan available through the Health Care Markets.
- Allow Medicare to negotiate drug prices, regulate misleading drug ads and permit safe reimportation of prescription drugs from Canada.

A New Era in Preventive and Chronic Care

Edwards will require coverage of preventive care at little or no cost and ensure that providers monitor chronically ill patients' health to reduce complications and hospitalizations.

Implement Information Technology

Edwards will require the use of electronic medical records to reduce duplicative tests and medical errors while protecting patients' privacy.

Evidence-Based Medicine

Edwards will create an objective source of reliable medical information to help doctors give the best care and a "Consumer Reports" for health care for patients.

NEW STRATEGIES FOR LONG-TERM CARE, CANCER, HIV/AIDS AND THE NURSING SHORTAGE

Choice and Dignity in Long-Term Care

Edwards will reform the long-term care system to create choices for older Americans and people with disabilities, provide home and community care and promote dignity for families and workers.

A National Strategy for Cancer Survivorship

- Ensure that Americans with cancer are diagnosed earlier and receive coordinated care, and strengthen family support networks.
- Double funding for research priorities, reduce risk factors and close racial and ethnic disparities.

End the HIV/AIDS Epidemic

- Guarantee care for HIV-positive individuals through Medicaid before the disease advances.
- Prevent HIV/AIDS with science-based steps and fight it in the African-American and Latino, as well as LGBT, communities.

Address the Nursing Shortage

- Graduate 50,000 new nurses by investing in nursing schools and scholarships.
- Bring back and retain 50,000 existing nurses with new safety standards, safe staffing ratios and a ban on mandatory overtime.

JOHN EDWARDS' TAX REFORM PLAN TO REWARD WORK

Summary

John Edwards will rewrite our tax code to make it simpler and fairer and to help hard-working families succeed. Millions of working and middle-class families will keep more of their paychecks. Those at the very top will again pay their fair share.

The Edwards Tax Reform Plan

- New tax breaks to strengthen the middle class
- Reward work, not just wealth, and repeal the Bush tax breaks for the wealthy
- Shut down special loopholes for insiders

NEW TAX BREAKS TO STRENGTHEN THE MIDDLE CLASS

"It's time for us to put our economy back in line with our values and strengthen three pillars of America's middle class: savings, work and family."

Encourage Savings

- Establish a new Get Ahead tax credit to match up to \$500 a year in retirement savings for families earning up to \$75,000.
- Create new Work Bonds to offer extra savings incentives for low-income workers.

Reward Work

 Expand the Earned Income Tax Credit to reward low-wage workers by tripling the EITC for single adults and cutting the marriage penalty.

Support Families

 More than double the Child and Dependent Care Credit to up to \$2,500 per child.

REWARD WORK, NOT JUST WEALTH

"It's time to stop promoting the wealth of the wealthy and start making sure that everyone has the chance to move up the economic ladder."

Restore Fair Taxation of Wealth

- Restore the investment income tax rate to 28 percent for Americans making more than \$250,000 a year so that wealthy investors don't pay a lower rate on investments than many regular Americans pay on wages.
 - Repeal the Bush tax cuts for households earning more than \$200,000 a year.
 - Keep the tax on very largest inheritances while protecting family businesses and family farms.

Simplify Taxes

 Simplify taxes for up to 50 million families by giving them the option of letting the IRS complete a first draft of their forms for "five-minute filing."

SHUT DOWN SPECIAL LOOPHOLES FOR INSIDERS

Declare War on Offshore Tax Havens

Edwards will fight offshore tax havens by working with other nations to fight tax evasion, crack down on tax shelter promoters and eliminate special tax breaks for corporations' offshore investments.

Close the Tax Gap

Edwards will collect a greater share of the \$300 billion in uncollected taxes every year through better IRS service, targeting audits at wealthy individuals and corporations likely to have committed evasion, and requiring more third-party reporting.

Close Hedge Fund and Private Equity Loopholes

Edwards will close the loophole that elite Wall Street traders use to pay only 15 percent in taxes on their huge incomes, while regular families often pay twice that amount.

JOHN EDWARDS' PLAN FOR SMART AND SAFE TRADE

Summary

Having grown up in Carolina mill towns, John Edwards understands the devastating impact trade can have on workers and communities. He will never sign bad trade deals like NAFTA or Peru. Instead he will make sure we have smart and safe trade policies that help regular families.

The Edwards Plan for Smart and Safe Trade

- Smart and safe trade for working families
- Demand a level playing field
- Help affected workers and communities
- Strengthen import safety

SMART AND SAFE TRADE FOR WORKING FAMILIES

A New, Simple Test for Trade

Edwards will reject trade deals for corporate insiders that leave regular workers out in the cold. Instead he will insist on making families better off.

Demand Strong Labor Laws

- Require our trading partners to adopt and enforce basic workers' rights to lift up workers around the world, unlike the failed NAFTA deal.
- Pursue stronger labor laws by linking them to U.S. trade preference programs, any new bilateral trade agreements and future WTO negotiations.

Require Environmental Standards

Edwards will demand environmental standards to prevent multinational companies from exploiting weak laws and enforcement in other countries.

Fight Currency Manipulation

Edwards will insist that trade deals include strong, clear language on impermissible currency manipulation and make it easier for the Treasury Department to act on unfair trade practices of countries like China.

DEMAND A LEVEL PLAYING FIELD

"Today, trade negotiators charged with enforcing agreements seem to think their job is done when an agreement is signed. Signing a trade deal should be the beginning of the process, not the end."

Prosecute Violations of Trade Deals

- Assign top Justice Department prosecutors to enforce trade deals.
- Go after illegal trade subsidies and insist that China and other countries end manipulation of their currencies.
- Seek WTO sanctions if necessary.

End Offshore Incentives

 Eliminate the tax breaks that let multinational corporations avoid most or all of their taxes by investing in tax havens, giving them an incentive to move overseas.

HELP AFFECTED WORKERS AND COMMUNITIES

"We need to stop bad trade deals. When workers or communities are hurt by trade, we need to invest in those communities much earlier and more aggressively."

Create the Training Works Initiative

- Build career ladders to help low-wage workers gain skills and move into jobs that support families through partnerships of businesses, unions and community colleges.
- Help unemployed workers who have promising business ideas with entrepreneur grants, mentoring and continued unemployment benefits.

Help Dislocated Communities

Edwards will intervene in communities facing mass layoffs with resources, expertise, and planning modeled after military base closing aid.

Strengthen the Job Safety Net

 Offer extended unemployment insurance and training benefits to all workers dislocated by globalization, regardless of their industry.

 Modernize unemployment insurance to cover 500,000 more workers a year.

STRENGTHEN IMPORT SAFETY

Protect the Food We Eat

Edwards will enforce country of origin labeling on food, reform and expand food inspection and require countries selling food to American families to have safety systems that meet tough standards.

Ensure Toy Safety

Edwards will have zero tolerance for unsafe toys, increase penalties for violations and require independent testing for safety.

Block Counterfeit Medicine

Edwards will require pharmaceutical companies to trace drug shipments electronically, ensuring that they remain safe.

Summary

Organized labor is the most important anti-poverty movement in American history, helping create millions of good jobs and strengthening the middle class.

The Edwards Plan for Working Families

- Strengthen labor laws
- Enact smarter trade policies
- Defend good jobs
- Ensure worker safety and help injured workers
- Set real standards for government outsourcing

Strengthen Labor Laws

Federal law promises workers the right to choose a union, but the law is poorly enforced and routinely violated by employers.

- Pass the Employee Free Choice Act to give workers a real choice in whether to form a union.
- Make penalties for breaking labor laws tougher and faster.
- Ban permanent replacement of striking workers.

Enact Smarter Trade Policies

Trade deals need to benefit American workers, not just increase profits for multinational corporations. Edwards will aggressively enforce deals on the books and will require any new trade agreements to include strong standards on labor, the environment and currency manipulation.

Defend Good Jobs

In many industries, violations of our most basic labor laws have become the new way of doing business.

- Restore workers' rights to overtime.
- Stop companies from mislabeling employees "independent contractors" to avoid paying benefits and taxes.

 Expand minimum wage protections for tipped workers and home care workers.

Ensure Worker Safety and Help Injured Workers

Simply doing your job should not cause you harm.

- Protect every American worker with federal safety and health standards, including new ergonomics standards and stronger OSHA enforcement.
- Strengthen protections for whistleblowers who report injuries or unsafe conditions.
- Work with states to reform workers' compensation.

Set Real Standards for Government Outsourcing

- Give public employees a fair chance to compete with private contractors.
- Recognize that work involving essential governmental functions should never be privatized.
- Evaluate companies' records on tax, labor, environmental and other laws before awarding federal contracts.

JOHN EDWARDS' PLAN TO RESTORE HOPE TO RURAL AMERICA

Summary

As someone who grew up in small rural towns, John Edwards knows that America cannot turn its back on rural areas. Small towns and rural areas are the keepers of American values like family, work, community and freedom.

The Edwards Rural Recovery Act

- Restore economic fairness
- Help rural towns and counties grow
- Protect the rural way of life

RESTORE ECONOMIC FAIRNESS

"Any talk of rural recovery has to start with the economy. Farms and small businesses have been stabbed in the heart by unfair competition. We need to help small towns and rural communities create and keep new businesses and good jobs."

Invest Seed Money for Rural Recovery

Edwards will create the Rural Economic Advancement Challenge (REACH) Fund to:

- Give Main Street businesses the seed money they need for startup and expansion.
- Connect rural entrepreneurs with investors and advisors.
- Organize local businesses into networks to help them succeed together.

Create the New Energy Economy in Rural America

- Establish the \$13 billion New Energy Economy Fund to jumpstart renewable energies like wind, solar and biofuels.
- Expand markets for ethanol by requiring new cars to run on both gasoline and E85 ethanol and requiring 25 percent of chain gas stations to carry E85.

Support locally-owned biorefineries with start-up capital and train residents for "green collar" energy jobs.

Create Fairness for Family Farmers

- Strictly enforce laws against anticompetitive mergers and unfair pricing and require country-of-origin labeling.
- Enact a strong national packer ban to protect small and medium-size farmers and ranchers against excessive industry consolidation.
- Impose a national moratorium on the construction or expansion of concentrated cattle and hog feeding operations.
- Help family farmers by limiting farm subsidies to \$250,000 and expand conservation programs.

Invest in Rural Broadband

- Prohibit telephone and cable companies from discriminating against rural communities in building broadband networks.
- Establish a goal of universal broadband by 2010, starting by identifying gaps in availability, price and speed.

Modernize the Community Reinvestment Act

 Require banks to invest in rural areas and rural small businesses.

HELP RURAL TOWNS AND COUNTIES GROW

Strengthen Rural Schools

 Address teacher shortages with higher pay and college scholarships for students who commit to teach in underserved rural schools.

Invest in distance learning technology to bring the content of the world's best universities, libraries and museums to rural areas.

Improve Rural Health Care

- Rewrite unfair Medicare and Medicaid funding formulas that punish rural areas.
- Recruit new nurses for rural clinics and hospitals by paying tuition for students who commit to serve for at least four years.
- Support telemedicine to instantaneously connect local doctors and patients to distant specialists and advanced equipment.

PROTECT THE RURAL WAY OF LIFE

Rid Rural America of Crystal Meth

Edwards will strengthen enforcement of drug laws in rural areas, make the ingredients of methamphetamines more difficult to get and expand treatment programs for addicts.

Protect Lawful Gun Ownership

Edwards will protect the right of law-abiding citizens to own firearms for protection, sport shooting and hunting, while also keeping guns out of the hands of criminals.

Support Hunting and Fishing

Edwards will increase access to public lands, support land and farm conservation programs and protect clean water for fishing.

The Edwards Immigration Reform Plan

- Secure our borders
- Provide an earned path to citizenship that requires English
- Preserve family reunification
- No new second-class of laborers
- End the backlog

Secure Our Borders

- Secure our borders and stop illegal trafficking.
- Double the number of border patrol agents and invest in surveillance technology to police the borders.
- Crack down on employers that hire undocumented immigrants.
- Vigorously enforce workplace laws and increase fines for businesses that knowingly break the rules.

Provide an Earned Path to Citizenship that Requires English

Edwards believes people who are already here should have the opportunity to earn American citizenship if they avoid a criminal record, pay a fine in recognition that they came here illegally and learn English – the surest path to success in this country.

Strengthen Families

Edwards believes family reunification is an important value that should be reflected in our immigration laws.

No New Second-Class of Laborers

Edwards opposes new temporary guestworker programs that do not provide adequate workplace protections and a reasonable path to citizenship.

End the Backlog

Edwards will end the background check backlog for legal immigrants applying for permanent residence.

- Prohibit abuses in the mortgage market, including prepayment penalties, mandatory arbitration, balloon loans and excessive fees.
- Strengthen underwriting standards so borrowers get loans they can afford and regulate non-bank lenders and mortgage brokers, some of whom have steered families into high-cost loans.

Create a Home Rescue Fund

 Help families facing foreclosure get more affordable mortgages and offer new bankruptcy relief so families can stay in their homes.

Support Credit Alternatives

 Help non-profits and states administer low or nointerest emergency loans as alternatives to pricey payday and credit card loans.

Help Families Save

- Create a Get Ahead credit to match \$500 in retirement savings up to dollar-for-dollar.
- Help banks offer free bank accounts to the 28 million Americans without them, so they can save and avoid exorbitant check-cashing fees.

Modernize Community Reinvestment Laws

- Reward financial institutions for marketing financial products to underserved consumers at fair terms.
- Monitor financial services to ensure all Americans have access.

JOHN EDWARDS' PLAN FOR ENDING THE WAR IN IRAQ

Summary

We must end this war and bring our troops home. There is no military solution to the chaos in Iraq. Instead, the Iraqi people must solve the problem politically by taking responsibility for their country.

The Edwards Plan to End the War

- Immediately withdraw 40-50,000 troops
- Withdraw all combat troops within nine to ten months
- Engage other nations to stabilize Iraq
- Redeploy troops outside Iraq

Immediately Withdraw 40-50,000 Troops

Edwards opposed President Bush's "surge" that escalated the war and supports immediately withdrawing 40,000 to 50,000 combat troops.

Withdraw All Combat Troops within 9 to 10 Months

- Completely withdraw all combat troops in Iraq within nine to ten months.
- Prohibit permanent U.S. military bases in Iraq.

Engage Other Nations to Stabilize Iraq

- Engage in direct talks with all nations in the region, including the governments of Iran and Syria, to bring a political solution to the sectarian violence inside Iraq.
- Convene a regional peace conference.

Redeploy Troops Outside Iraq

After withdrawal, we should keep Quick Reaction Forces outside Iraq, in friendly countries like Kuwait, to prevent an Al Qaeda safe haven, a genocide, or regional spillover of a civil war. Only minimal troops needed to protect the embassy and humanitarian workers will remain in Iraq; none will conduct combat missions.

Summary

America must be a global leader in the fight against poverty. Solving global poverty is a moral imperative and a security issue because poverty creates the breeding ground for instability and terrorism.

The Edwards Global Poverty Plan

- Enroll every child in primary school
- Invest in global public health
- Create political and economic opportunity

Enroll Every Child in School

Education is critical to bringing countries out of poverty, but more than 100 million young children are not in school. Edwards will endorse the goal of universal basic education by 2015 and commit \$3 billion a year to this cause – enough to enroll 23 million children – and encourage our allies to provide the remaining resources needed.

Invest in Global Public Health

- Double the U.S. investment in clean water and convene an international summit to make water safe worldwide by 2015.

- Rescind the "global gag rule" that bars U.S. family planning aid to foreign non-profits.

Create Political and Economic Opportunity

We can get to the root of global poverty by increasing political opportunity and economic opportunity. Democratic rights allow poor citizens to force their countries to create more progressive laws, fight oppression and demand economic stability.

- Invest in microenterprise programs that encourage entrepreneurship and provide an inexpensive way for poor families to achieve financial security.
- Expand support for the National Endowment for Democracy to strengthen democratic institutions in countries with a history of political violence.
- Promote labor, property and women's rights, encouraging nations to give all their citizens greater economic opportunity.

Establish a Cabinet-Level Post on Global Poverty

- Appoint a senior advisor responsible for global poverty to coordinate development policies across the federal government and be a voice at cabinet meetings for the fight against global poverty.
- Modernize, consolidate, and simplify foreign aid with a new Global Development Act and call on Congress to revamp its committee structure to create clearer and more effective lines of authority.

 Close shameful racial and ethnic health disparities with universal coverage, new research, low or nocost screenings, pro-active chronic disease treatment and increased diversity among health professionals.

Protect the Right to Vote

 Require voting machines in every neighborhood to be verifiable and accessible, fight voter suppression and allow ex-prisoners who have served their time to vote in federal elections.

Reform the Criminal Justice System

 Reform sentencing rules to address disparities for crack and powder cocaine, review mandatoryminimum sentences and prison alternatives for firsttime, non-violent offenses, and support re-entry programs that include treatment and education.
